### **PREPARATION TASKS**

London is the capital city of the UK and attracts millions of tourists each year. There are many different videos on London that you can watch on YouTube in order to find out more about this popular city destination. You can also visit the website <u>Visit London</u> where you will discover many of the attractions and facilities that London offers to visitors.

Imagine you work for The London Tourist Board and you have been asked to design a leaflet on London. The leaflet is aimed at promoting London as a destination to younger people aged 18 - 25 years. Your leaflet could be completed either on a Word document or by hand on A4 paper.

Consider the pictures you would include in the leaflet and which visitor attractions in London would appeal to this age group. Consider the type of accommodation such as a hotel where visitors to London can stay. Your brochure should be exciting, colourful and interesting. Remember that it should also appeal to younger people aged

18 - 25 years.





You should try to read as many tour operator's brochures as you can. You can obtain these free of charge from any high street travel agency. E-brochures are also available online from most tour operators e.g. <u>TUI</u>. This will help you learn about different holiday destinations around the world and the many types of accommodation where travelers can stay whilst they are on holiday.
